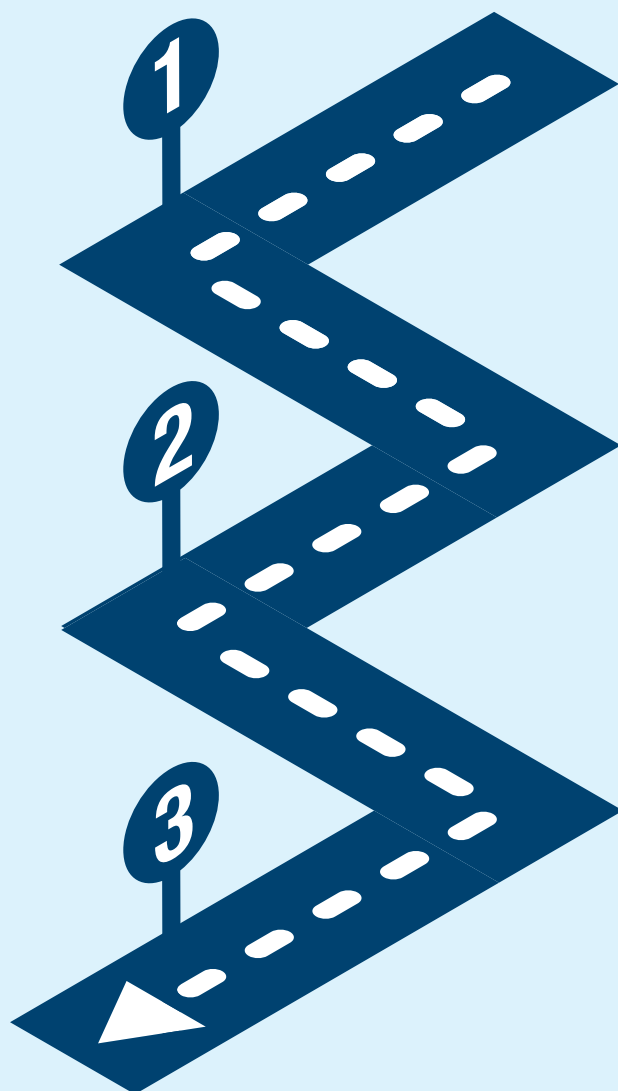

# ILLINOIS CAR SEAT LAW

## Requirement 1:

Children under the age of 2 must ride rear-facing.

## Requirement 2:

Restraint must be provided by parents or legal guardians.

## Requirement 3:

Every person transporting a child under 8 is responsible for properly securing the child.

71%



Car seats reduce the risk of infants (under age 1) being killed in cars by **71%**

54%



Car seats reduce the risk of toddlers (1 to 4 years old) being killed in cars by **54%**

92%



Rear-facing car seats reduce serious injuries by **92%**



Children that ride rear-facing are safer than those riding forward-facing.
