REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Registration Costs:

- \$50 through March 17
- \$75 March 18 - April 7
- No on-site registrations will be accepted

Waiver Options:

HOTEL: A limited block of rooms is available free of charge for attendees traveling more than 90 miles. Registration fee must be received before hotel waiver can be guaranteed. These complimentary rooms are available on a first come, first served basis. Eligible attendees must specify date for requested complimentary room on the registration form. Hotel rooms will be booked in the name listed on the registration form. At check-in, registrant must provide a credit card for incidentals. All confirmation details will be sent via email.

REGISTRATION: Registration reimbursement is available for attendees that live or work within 90 miles of the event. A limited number of reimbursements will be issued on a first come, first served basis. Eligible attendees must specify that they are requesting reimbursement on the registration form, pay the registration fee up front, and successfully complete the Child Passenger Safety Technical Update before being reimbursed. All confirmation details will be sent via email.

Cancellation Policy:

Registrants that cancel prior to March 24, 2017 are eligible for a full refund. No refunds will be given after this date. To cancel, please email a detailed request to DOT.BUCKLEUP@illinois.gov. Substitutions will be accepted through March 31, 2017.

KEYNOTE SPEAKER

Joe Colella is a nationally respected writer, program developer, consultant, speaker, instructor and advocate. He works with local and national organizations to address occupant protection and traffic safety issues. Joe's work includes efforts in 47 states, the District of Columbia, Israel, Canada and Japan. He previously served as Chairman of the National Child Passenger Safety Board and was one of the initial 16 instructors for the National Standardized CPS Training Program. Joe is known for his research based approach to developing quality, specialized Child Passenger Safety instruction.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Registration fee must be paid in order to be eligible for hotel room waiver.
- Hotel rooms cannot be requested prior to registration - no holds or exceptions.
- Hotel room waivers are available on a first come, first served basis.
- Registration fee reimbursements are available on a first come, first served basis.
- Registrations post-marked through March 17, 2017 - \$50.
- Registrations post-marked after March 17, 2017 - \$75.
- No on-site registrations will be accepted.
- You must be currently certified - as of 4/10/17 - as a Child Passenger Safety Technician/Instructor to attend.
