Steps to National Child Passenger Safety (CPS) Recertification

- ✓ **Step 1** Install 5 selected child safety seats and have an Instructor sign off on them.
- ✓ **Step 2** Conduct at least 4 hours of CPS community education to groups of uncertified people, or participate in at least one 2 hour car seat check with at least one other technician and keep the documentation.
- ✓ **Step 3** Obtain 6 Continuing Education Units (CEUs).*
- ✓ **Step 4** Register for recertification at www.safekids.org/certification, enter data and pay \$40.00 recertification fee before your expiration date.**

**The Illinois CPS Update Courses will provide you ALL 6 Continuing Education Units needed for recertification; however, your recertification will not be complete unless you log-on to www.safekids.org/certification and complete all of the above steps.*

***Note: The \$40.00 national recertification fee is separate from the Illinois CPS Course registration fee.*

Things to Remember

- The recertification process must be entered ENTIRELY on-line at www.safekids.org/certification. You will need your username and password to navigate the Safe Kids website. If you do not know your username and password, please call 1-877-366-8154 to obtain it.
- Your certification is for 2 years, so it would be good practice to enter your data as soon as you complete activities. For example – if you attend a CPS update course and get CEUs, log those CEUs onto the Safe Kids website ASAP, so you don't forget, and you can keep better track of what you still need to do.
- There is no certification grace period. If you do not complete all of the steps to recertify by your expiration date, your certification will expire.
