Regional CPS Workshops

We're listening. In response to your needs, we're bringing CPS conference workshops to your area. In 2008, instead of one statewide CPS conference, there will be four regional CPS workshops. Look for us up North, in Central Illinois, Southern Illinois and Chicago! Each of these workshops will provide an opportunity for CPS Technicians & Instructors to obtain all 6 CEUs needed for recertification. Even if you already have enough CEUs to recertify, you should still plan to attend. We'll share the latest information on vehicle safety technology, advances in child safety seats and much more. It's time for an update! We'll see you in your neighborhood.

Things to Remember

- The recertification process must be entered ENTIRELY online at www.safekids.org/certification. You will need your username and password to navigate the Safe Kids website. If you do not know your username and password, please call 1-877-366-8154 to obtain it.
- Your certification is for 2 years, so it would be good practice to enter your data as soon as you complete activities. For example - if you attend a CPS workshop and get CEUs, log those CEUs onto the Safe Kids website ASAP, so you don't forget, and you can keep better track of what you still need to do.
- There is no certification grace period. If you do not complete all of the steps to recertify by your expiration date, your certification will expire.
- We're here to help! Contact your regional coordinator if you have questions about recertification.

Steps to CPS Recertification

- Install 5 selected child safety seats and have an Instructor sign off on them.
- Conduct at least 4 hours of CPS community education to groups of uncertified people, or participate in at least one 2 hour car seat check and keep the documentation.
- Obtain 6 Continuing Education Units (CEUs). All 6 CEUs may be obtained at the 2008 regional CPS workshops. You can also obtain CEUs by auditing a CPS standardized course, attending teleconferences or online/web sessions and by reading journal articles or newsletters with CPS technical content.
- Register and pay \$40.00 for CPS certification before your expiration date. This can be done at www.safekids.org/certification.
