



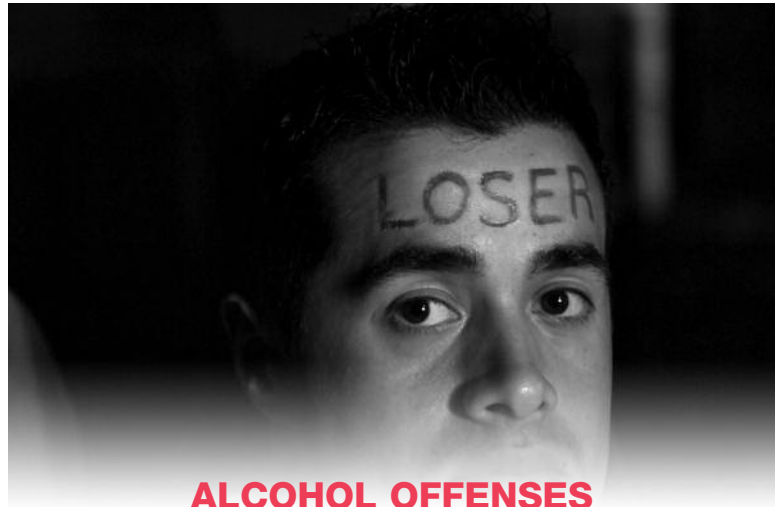
ARE YOU **SMART ENOUGH?** TO STAY OUT OF JAIL!

DRIVING OFFENSES

If you are under age 21 and drive with **any** alcohol in your system, you will lose your license for 3 months.

If you are under age 21 and drive with an illegal blood alcohol limit of 0.08 or greater, you will lose your license for a minimum 6 months (minimum 2 years if convicted of DUI) and pay fines up to \$2,500. If you are 18 or older, in order to receive driving relief during the time of your license suspension and/or revocation you will also be required to operate only vehicles equipped with a Breath Alcohol Ignition Interlock Device (BAIID).

If you are age 21 or older and drive with an illegal blood alcohol content of 0.08 or greater, you will lose your license for a minimum 6 months (minimum 1 year if convicted of DUI) and pay fines up to \$2,500. In order to receive driving relief during the time of your license suspension and/or revocation you will also be required to operate only vehicles equipped with a BAIID.



ALCOHOL OFFENSES

If you are under age 21 and you are convicted of purchasing, possessing or consuming alcohol, you will lose your license for a minimum of 1 year.

If you are age 21 or older and you are convicted of providing alcohol to a minor, you face 1 year possible imprisonment and fines up to \$2,500.

If you are convicted of having open alcohol in your car, you will lose your license for 1 year.

FRAUDULENT IDENTIFICATION OFFENSES

If you have fraudulent identification, you will lose your license for 1 year, and face possible imprisonment of 1 year and fines up to \$2,500.

If you allow another person to use your driver's license, you will lose your license for 1 year, and face 1 year possible imprisonment and fines up to \$2,500.
